The following questions were received by close of business on January 13, 2012 concerning RFQ No. 12-31-034-00 for Construction Management Services, Materials Testing, and Construction Surveying for the Construction of the I-215 Widening, Scott Road to Nuevo Road, Project. The Riverside County Transportation Commission ("Commission" or "RCTC") responses below are being provided for purposes of clarification only and do not revise, change or qualify any information contained in the RFQ. The RFQ was issued on 12/12/11. Submittals are due by 2:00 p.m. on 2/09/12.

**Question No. 1**

What is the estimated construction cost for the I-215 Widening, Scott Rd. to Nuevo Rd., Project?

The 95% engineer's estimate which includes supplemental and contingency is approximately \$95 million.

What is the target construction schedule?

**RCTC plans to advertise the construction project in August/September 2012.**

Does the materials testing firm need to be Caltrans certified?

The awarded firm will be managing a construction contract which will have federal money on it so it needs to be aware of all of the federal requirements that the contractor must follow.**

**The Safety Coordinator is responsible for Traffic Safety and Construction safety. Traffic Safety includes monitoring traffic conditions and the implementation of traffic safety items (k-rail, crash cushions, etc). It also involves the coordination with the CHP on COZEEP with accident and incident reports. As directed by the RE , the Safety Coordinator will work with Caltrans’ Traffic Management center on Lane Closure requests and prepare monthly lane closure summaries.**
